

SAMPLES OF SPOKEN ENGLISH FOR ASSESSMENT

- 'hands up' contributions (teacher asks-pupil answers)
- reading aloud (e.g. round class: dramatic reading)
- prepared solo talk/presentation
- 'just a minute' (improvised one-minute talk about a 'light' topic, e.g. the importance of matches)
- 'show and tell' (pupil brings an object from home, which means a lot to her/him, shows it to her/his classmates, they ask questions, he/she answers them, preparation at home has to anticipate questions)
- describe and draw (teacher or pupil dictates s. th., the others draw it)
- giving instructions (e.g. *Simon says*)
- teacher-monitored group work
- teacher interviews pupil (recorded on an MP3 player)
- pupil interviews others (recorded on an MP3 player)
- role-plays in class or recorded on an MP3 player
- class play / own sketches
